Stallholder Terms & Conditions

Thank you for your interest in being part of the 2027 Mudgee Show & Rodeo. These Terms & Conditions apply to all stallholders, traders, food vendors, craft stallholders and community or voluntary organisations participating in the event.

By submitting a Stallholder Application, applicants acknowledge that they have read and agree to these Terms & Conditions.

1. Applications & Site Allocation

Submit all stallholder applications through the Mudgee Show Society online Stallholder Application. Submission of an application does not guarantee acceptance or allocation of a site. Applications are assessed as they are received, and all site allocations are at the discretion of Mudgee Show Society. The Society reserves the right to relocate a stallholder where required for the safe and effective operation of the Show.

2. Confirmation & Payment

Successful applicants will be advised of their site allocation and provided with payment details. A site is not confirmed until the application has been approved and payment has been received in full. Applications should be submitted no later than the Friday two weeks prior to the Show. Late applications may be considered at the discretion of Mudgee Show Society.

3. Insurance

All stallholders must hold their own current Public Liability Insurance and provide a current Certificate of Currency with their application. This requirement applies to commercial traders, food vendors, craft stallholders and community or voluntary organisations.

4. Set-up & Trading

All exhibits and stalls must be fully set up and ready to trade by 8.00am Friday and remain in place for the duration of the Show & Rodeo. Stallholders who pack up or leave before the permitted time may jeopardise future trade space opportunities at Mudgee Show and affiliated shows.

5. Pack-up & Vehicle Movement

Stallholder vehicles are not permitted in public areas before 9.00pm. Where packing is required prior to this time, items must be carried to vehicles. Vehicles may only enter or move through public areas once permitted by Show officials.

6. Parking

Parking will generally be available behind stall sites where site location permits. Parking may not be available immediately behind sites located within the main event or other prime areas. Vehicles must not be moved during the event while public access restrictions are in place.

7. Site Sharing

Site sharing is permitted; however, sub-letting of sites is not permitted. Where a site is shared, the two site-holder passes allocated to that site must also be shared, or additional passes must be purchased.

8. Site Holder Passes

Two site-holder passes will be issued for each standard trade site. Additional passes for staff may be purchased. Community & Voluntary Organisation sites: Each adult attending the stall is required to purchase a Mudgee Show Society Adult Membership (\$23), which provides entry for both days of the Show.

9. Power & Electrical Requirements

Power is available for an additional \$20, subject to availability. Stallholders requiring power must nominate their requirements, including the number of outlets and total wattage, as part of their online application. Stallholders are responsible for providing their own compliant electrical leads and fixtures.

10. Food Vendors

Food vendors are responsible for complying with all applicable regulations. Some food and drink items may be subject to sponsorship arrangements. Successful food vendors will be advised of any arrangements affecting their product lines. Food vendors, other than Showmen, are not permitted to sell waffles, Dagwood Dogs or fairy floss.

11. Show Bags & Prohibited Items

Show bag standards must comply with the standards set by the Royal Agricultural Show Society. Only RAS-approved show bags and products may be sold. In keeping with the Society's commitment to providing a family-friendly event, stallholders must not sell or exhibit items of an explicit or obscene nature, or items promoting or referring to prohibited substances. Mudgee Show Society reserves the right to require the removal of any item deemed to contravene this condition.

The following items are specifically prohibited in accordance with applicable Show regulations:

Explicit or hardcore T-shirts; explicit DVDs and videos; fake cigarettes; fuel-type fire lighters (Zippo); iridescent hair spray; trumpets; knives (including pen knives); metal and wooden martial arts nunchakus; laser penlights and laser toys; nude or lewd playing cards; pressure-pack items including gas, snow and silly string; drug-related goods; water pistols longer than 150mm; water bombs; stink bombs; guns including pellet, ball-bearing, bullet-type, pop-down and cap guns; and fireworks.

12. Site Locations

Site locations are carefully planned to provide the best possible layout for stallholders, visitors and the overall operation of the Show. Once a site has been allocated, stallholders should not expect their location to be changed on arrival. Mudgee Show Society reserves the right to relocate a site where operational or safety requirements make this necessary.
